Legislative Budget Update

Budget Conference and Final Passage

- Conference committees met this week at Appropriation sub-Committee levels
- Unresolved issues have been "bumped" to full Appropriation Chairs
- If necessary, Senate President and House Speaker will resolve issues
- 72-hour "cooling off" period after the Conference Committee Report is released before each chamber can vote on final version of the budget
- Conference Committee Report must be released by Tuesday, March 8
- Last day of Regular Session: Friday, March 11, 2022

Current Status of Budget Negotiations

- House and Senate appear to have agreed on total funding amount
- House offering proviso language to FHFC line item
- Senate has not accepted the House proviso language
- Issue has been "bumped" to Appropriation Committee Chairs
- House proviso "Funds in Specific Appropriation 2289 are appropriated to the Florida Housing Finance Corporation to establish a Florida Hometown Hero Housing Program to provide down payment and closing cost assistance to eligible homebuyers."
- This would leave SAIL completely unfunded
- There are unappropriated funds available to use as part of final compromise

HB 837 (R-Willhite) SB 578 (R-Hooper) Hurricane Loss Mitigation Program	Extends HLMP to 2032	House: passed full House Senate: to be heard on Senate floor (3/4)

SB 1170 (R-Brandes) HB 1553 (R-Plakon) State Housing Assistance Programs	Makes substantive changes to SHIP, repeals SAIL and CWHIP	H/S: referred to 3 committees each
