State Non-Congregate Sheltering Program

Housing Assistance Applications	
Total Applicants Received:	5,888
Total Applicants Approved for NCS:	896
Total Individuals Licensed:	321
Total Households Licensed:	125

Travel Trailers	
Total Travel Trailers Ordered:	2,427
Total Travel Trailers On-Hand:	403
Total Work Orders Issued:	202
Total Travel Trailers installed:	175

- In addition to FEMA assistance, the State, through the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM), will deploy travel trailers (TT) and recreational vehicles (RV) as a sheltering option to survivors in the 26 IA designated counties whose homes are uninhabitable.
- This is a short-term (6-month) program with a focus on transitioning survivors into longer term housing. The State program provides sheltering assistance that compliments the FEMA Section 408 Direct Temporary Housing Mission.

- **Overview:**
 - Supports homeowners with emergency and permanent repairs to their property with the goal of turning their home into a habitable shelter until full rebuilding can be accomplished.
- **Current Updates:**
 - The State's partnership with Home Depot has been solidified; they will be providing the materials necessary to perform the repairs.
 - 3 properties have been identified for potential homes to be repaired.
 - The State has solidified a second VOAD partner- Inspiritus
- **To apply to this program:**
 - Survivors will use the same link through Unite Florida portal to apply

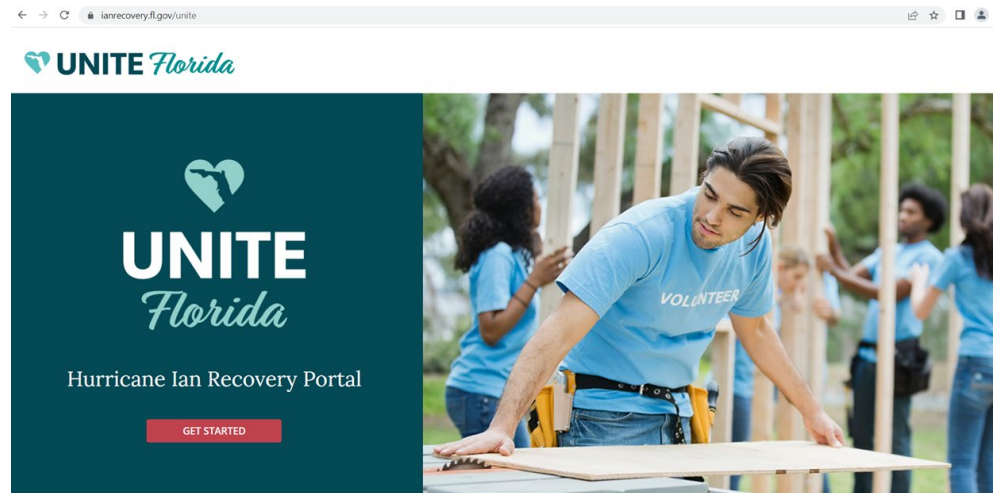
