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Apply for FEMA Individual Assistance

Apply for Disaster Assistance

Internet or Smartphone Application: Disaster survivors may apply for the Individuals and Households Program or check their application status at www.DisasterAssistance.gov. Disaster survivors may also access FEMA via smartphone by downloading the application from www.fema.gov or through their mobile provider's application store.

By Phone: Disaster survivors may call FEMA toll-free at 800-621-3362 to register for assistance or check their application status. Disaster survivors who are deaf, hard of hearing, or have a speech disability and use a Text Telephone (TTY) may call 800-462-7585. Disaster survivors who use 711 or VRS (Video Relay Service) may call 800-621-3362.

In Person: Visit a Disaster Recovery Center.

- For locations, check FEMA's mobile app www.fema.gov/mobile-app or call 1-800-621-3362, or visit www.DisasterAssistance.gov.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance team members may visit door-to-door in your area. They will have official FEMA photo identification.

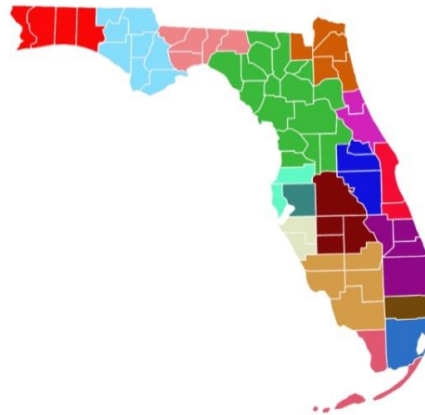

ADA Paratransit Screenings

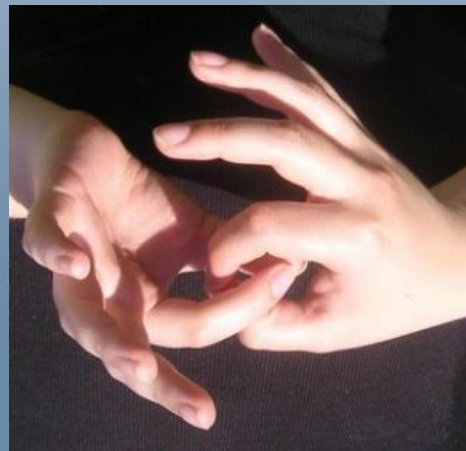
- Access to door to door service
 - Marion Transportation
- Access to Sun Tran fixed route system
- Must have a documented disability
- Professional verification required
 - Physician
 - Social Worker
 - OT/PT
 - Rehab Counselor
 - ARNP





Sign Language Interpreting Services

- Services are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Sign language interpreters are provided in a variety of venues
- Title III states that public accommodations are required to provide qualified interpreters to ensure effective communication

DME Closet

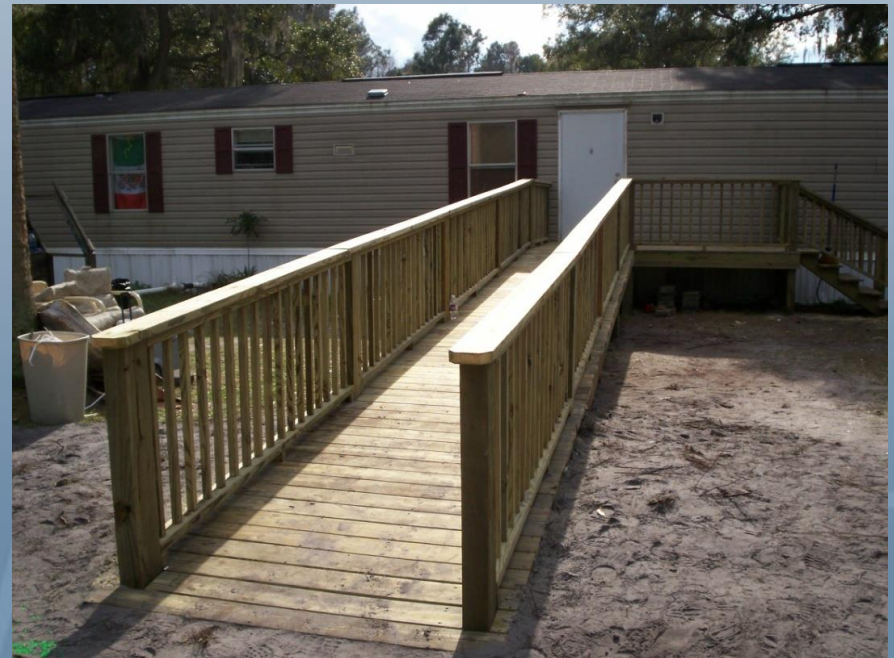
- Durable medical equipment available:
 - Wheelchairs
 - Walkers
 - Sliding Boards (new only)
 - Canes
 - Shower Chairs (new only)
- Equipment can be loaned out indefinitely based on need.





Wheelchair Ramps

- Grant funded
- Volunteer organized
- We receive up to 80 requests per year, but are only able to build about 30



Accessibility Studies

- Technical assistance
- Advocacy
- Address barriers in the community





Disability Awareness Training

- Emphasis on people first language
- Proper etiquette
- Provided to:
 - Government agencies
 - Educators
 - Social service staff
 - Businesses
 - Transit staff
 - Supervisor of Elections
