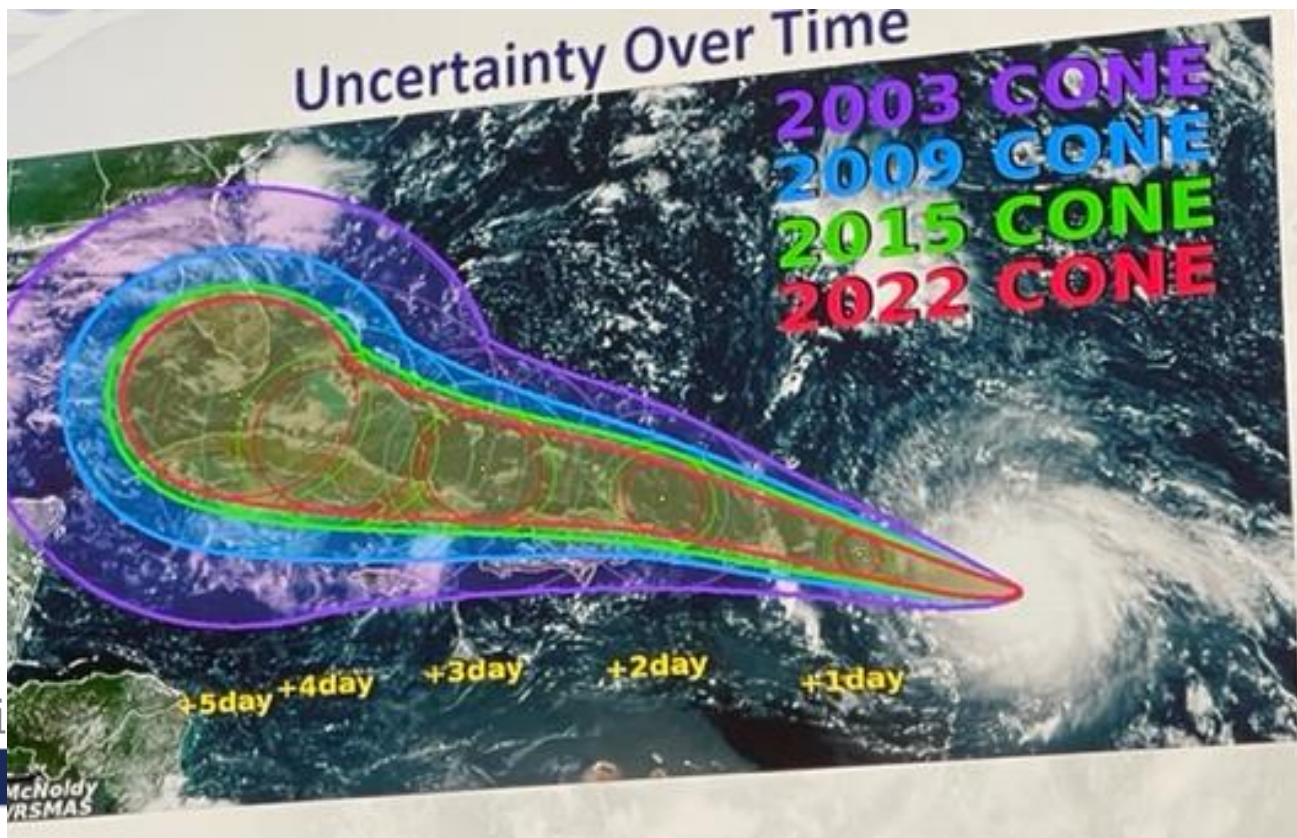

- Forecasting is becoming more accurate, consistent

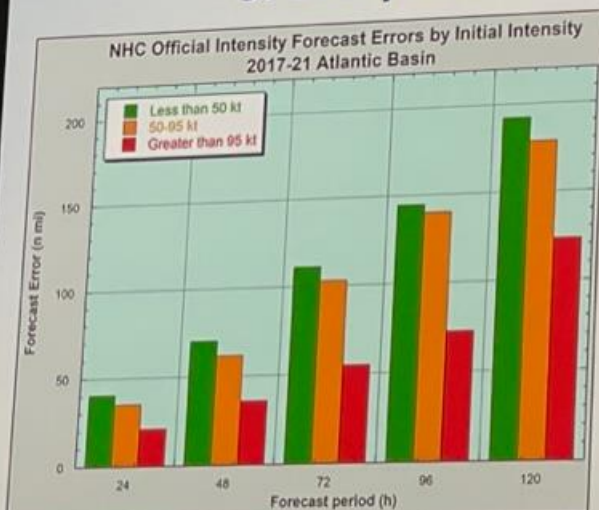

As the initial intensity of the storm increases, NHC average track error gets smaller!

It Has Been BUSY

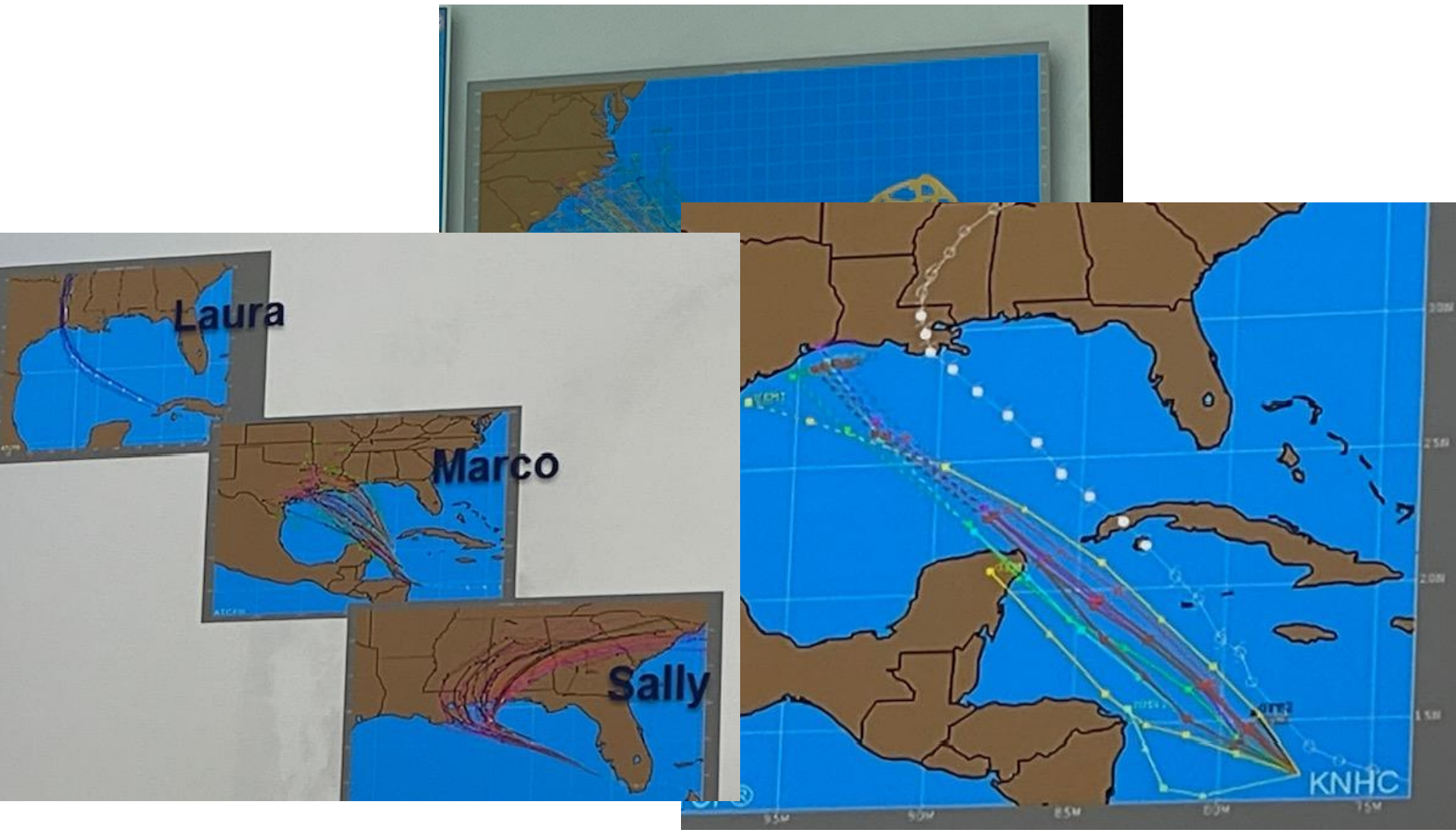


- 2021 was the 3rd most active in terms of named storms and the 5th costliest at over \$75 billion. (2020 we had the most names, 2005 was 2nd)

Primary Causes:

- 13 heat related
- 6 Carbon Monoxide

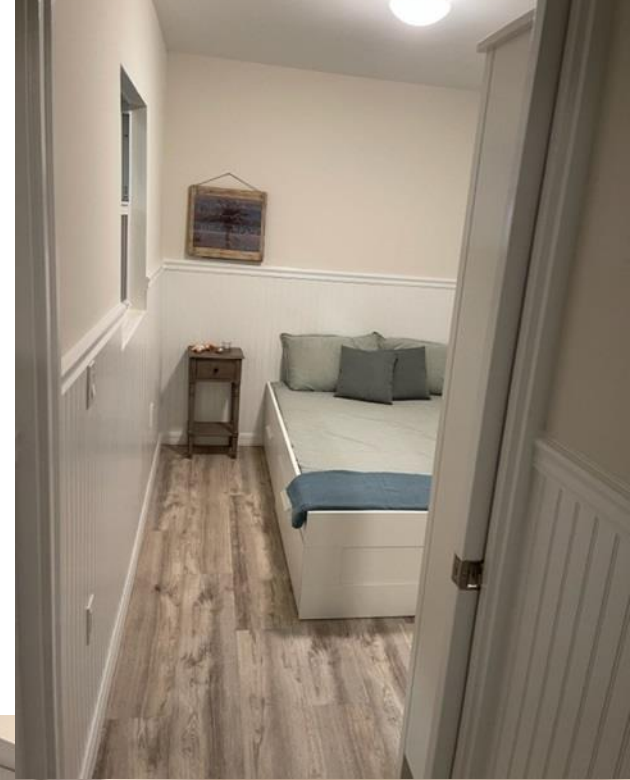

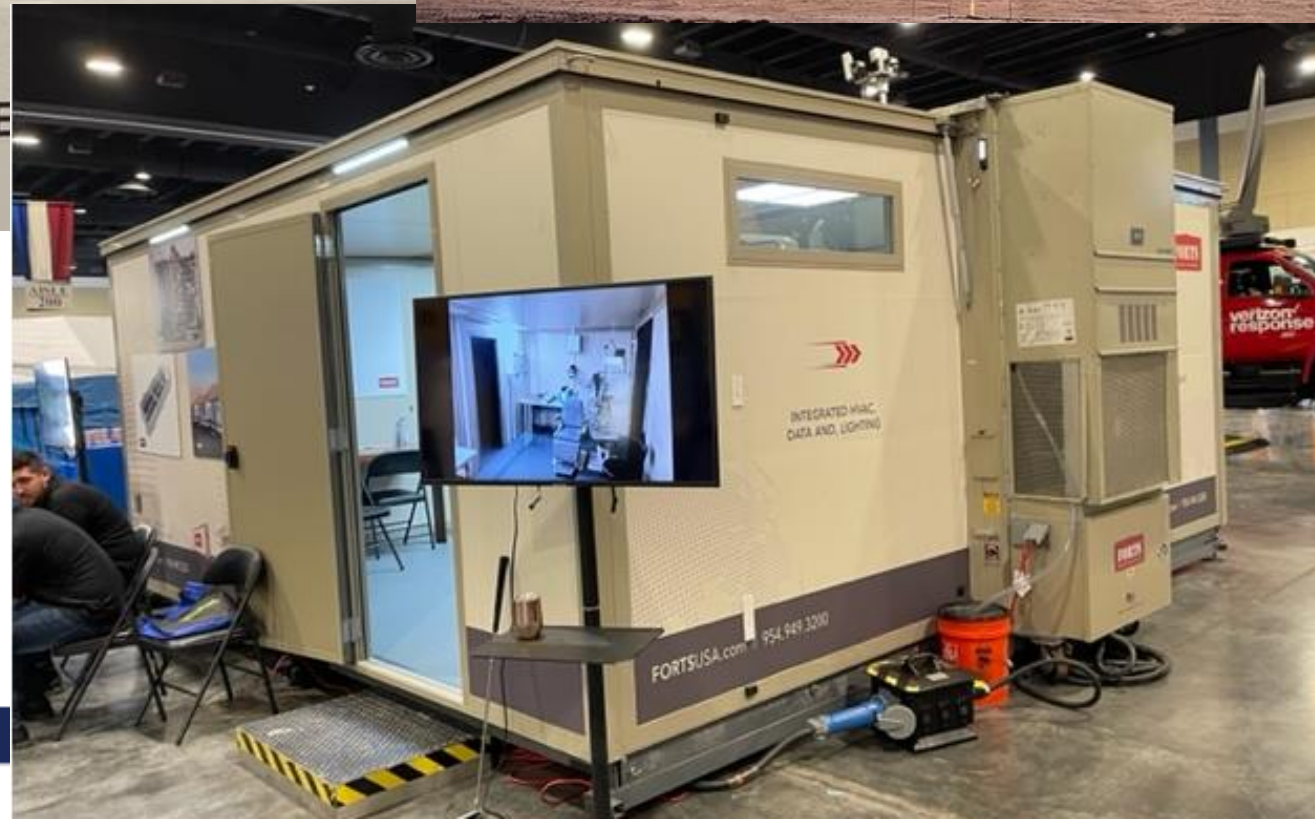
