- SELF was the first hybrid, nonprofit; *CDFI "Green Bank" in the Country focused 100% on serving low to moderate income communities.
- SELF was created in 2010 with a \$3million seed grant from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE).
- SELF has deployed over \$40 million in direct loans for over 3,700 projects for mostly LMI households (73%) leveraging over \$90+ million in total project costs.



Our Mission

SELF Loan Programs



Homeowners: Unsecured loans for upgrades to single-family and small multifamily properties based on ability to repay, not credit scores.



Landlords: Unsecured Energy Efficiency and Resiliency Loans for Affordable Rental & workforce housing upgrades.



Developers: Predevelopment, Gap; Construction and mini-perms.



SAGE: Special flexible financing program for BIPOC, Novice Developers w/ Technical Assistance.



SOLAR Residential Commercial and ITC Bridge Loans for Nonprofits





Contractors: Commercial No-dealer fee access to financing; training; workforce development programs.

Target projects?

Single-family homes and multifamily rentals in low-

income and disadvantaged communities

Funding size?

Low-income home: 100% grant

Moderate-income home: 60% grant + special financing

Multifamily: 10% grant + special financing









Florida Solar for All Beneficiaries

Low-Income Households

- 20% utility bill savings
- Households at or below 80% area median income (AMI)
- Sliding scale subsidies based on income, including low-interest financing options

Solar Contractors

- Disadvataged Business
 Enterprises (DBE)
 - Davis Bacon ActCompliant
 - Prevailing Wages
 - Payroll Reporting
 - Cap on \$/watt
 - Apprenticeship program

Workforce Training

Statewide paid apprenticeship program (FSEAP)
